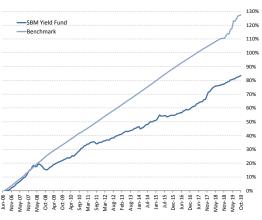

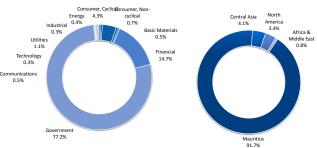

Market Commentary

The Net Asset Value (NAV) of the Fund stood at MUR 10.74 as at October 2019, registering a return of 0.3% over the month, while the benchmark yielded 0.2% in MUR terms over the same period.

There was no issuance of 91D Treasury Bills, 10Y, 15Y and 20Y GOM Bonds on the primary market during the month. The GOM issued MUR 1,900Mn worth of 364D Treasury Bills in three tranches of MUR 600Mn at weighted average yields of 2.63%, 2.72% and 2.91%, respectively. Yields on 182D Treasury Bills fell by 38 basis points to 2.60% during the month following a net issuance of MUR 600Mn. The GoM issued MUR 3,600Mn worth of 3Y GOM Notes in two tranches of MUR 1,800Mn at weighted average yields of 3.60% and 3.56%, respectively. SY GOM Bonds stood at 3.92%, shedding 12 basis points compared to previous month reading for a net issuance of MUR 1,600Mn.

GoM Treasury Bills traded at lower yields in October as compared to the previous month on the local fixed income market. 91D Treasury Bills traded at a weighted average yield of 2.39% against 2.41% in September. 182D Treasury Bills traded at a weighted average yield of 2.52% against 2.66% in the preceding month while 364D Treasury Bills traded at an average yield of 2.64% against 2.80%. 31 GOM Notes traded at a weighted average yield of 3.56% while SY GOM Bonds traded at 3.92% compared to previous month readings of 3.22% and 3.89%, respectively. 15Y GOM Bonds witnessed the same trend, trading at an average of 4.99% against 4.98% in September.

On the foreign fixed income front, the Barclays Global Aggregate Bond Index registered a positive USD return of 0.7% in October. US 10-year Treasury yield remained stable at around 1.69% following the 25bps Fed rate cuts. The yield curve reverted to normal after the announcement by the Fed that it would start expanding its balance sheet by buying USD 60Bn of short-term Treasury bills each month in view of increasing liquidity in the economy.

Following its last monetary committee policy (MPC) meeting held in October, the European Central Bank (ECB) announced that the interest rate on the main refinancing operations and the interest rates on the marginal lending facility and the deposit facility will remain unchanged at 0.00%, 0.25% and 0.50% respectively. As discussed in the September MPC meeting, net purchases of EUR 208n on a monthly basis will restart as from 1 November, in view of reinforring the accommodative impact of ECR's policy rates. Government bond yields across the euro area rose over support from an unexpected rise in German's industrial output, Brexit optimism and overall improved investor sentiment globally. German 10-year yields rose from -0.615 to -0.41% on reports that the EU and UK was close to a deal, thereby boosting investor appetite for riskier assets. The 10-year yields on UK Gilts added 14bps to its previous reading in September to reach 0.63%

The Bank of Japan (BoJ) kept its monetary policy steady during its meeting in October by maintaining its short-term rate target at -0.1% and that of long-term yields at around 0%, but signalled that there might be a rate cut in the near future.

On the emerging market fixed income front, 10-year Indian yields shed 25 basis points, falling from 6.70% to 6.45% in October following a rate cut by the RBI during the month. China's 10-year yields rose from 3.14% to 3.28%.
